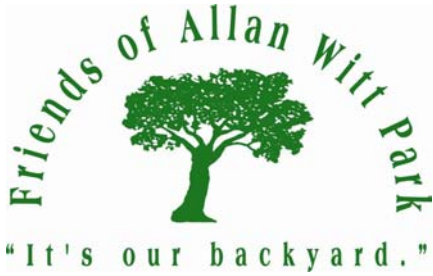


KEEP ALL 8 TENNIS COURTS IN ALLAN WITT PARK!



We demand that the City Council keep all eight lighted tennis courts in Allan Witt Park and not approve any redevelopment project that will destroy any of the public tennis courts. Recent proposals to sell 1/3 of the park for private development have required the removal of courts. Other Solano cities provide more public tennis courts for fewer residents! Fairfield should be building additional courts, not removing them. It is the City Council's duty as elected officials to preserve our parks and promote recreational activities, like tennis, to enhance the health and quality of life of Fairfield residents.

Preserve Allan Witt Park and keep all 8 tennis courts!

1. We believe that tennis is an affordable and healthy activity for children, youth and adults that should be encouraged and promoted within the City of Fairfield, and at the free public courts at Allan Witt Park.
2. We support making Allan Witt Park an excellent public space and popular destination for both residents and out-of-town visitors, and we believe that requires keeping all 8 tennis courts at the park.
3. We support new recreational facilities to benefit Fairfield, including development of a world-class sports complex, but not by trading tennis courts at Allan Witt Park for ball fields at another location.
4. We believe Fairfield must keep its only site with 8 public tennis courts to host USTA, Jr. League and other tennis tournaments, and to keep participation in tournaments and tennis clubs publicly accessible to all of Fairfield's citizens, not just those who belong to the private tennis clubs in Fairfield.
5. We urge the Community Services department to resume activities that promote use of the tennis courts at Allan Witt Park, including tennis tournaments, so that the public can have continued access to public tennis tournaments and join public tennis teams at Allan Witt Park, as has been previously enjoyed in the past..
6. We believe there is a vital need for the preservation of all 8 tennis courts in Allan Witt Park so that public access to public tennis tournament play, (including Junior, Senior, adult USTA and NTRP tennis tournaments) as well as active USTA tennis clubs & other local more casual tennis teams, tennis drop-ins, tennis classes and any other tennis activities that the public wishes to engage in, will continue to thrive and improve, as the city and the public work together to take a more proactive approach to improving it's current tennis program in Allan Witt Park regardless of other improvements to Allan Witt Park or increased population density surrounding the park.
